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AIS Hogan – Ceremonial Use Addendum to the Hogan Agreement

A. Northern Arizona University is an educational Institution. Hereby, the NAU Hogan was constructed to serve as an educational facility. Any other use of the NAU Hogan other than for educational use of NAU students will require permission from the AIS staff.

1. Counseling by AIS staff, for educational, health and personal welfare of NAU students is permitted.
2. Native American ceremonies normally require input by extended family members, including Clan Aunts, Uncles, grandparents and consulting elders, spiritual leaders. Therefore, Native American students whose relative have to travel long distance for ceremonial purposes will obtain permit from AIS staff.

B. Native American games, songs and dances, general meetings, practice tribal traditional games, gatherings for fun, education and feasting will require permission from AIS staff.

C. NAU colleges, schools, programs and club use of NAU will require permission.

1. All of the above requesting facility use upon approval, will keep the NAU Hogan clean, use the Hogan in a safe and respectful manner. Obey all laws; Federal, State, City, County and Tribal when using the NAU Hogan.
